Homewood is accessible via Interstate 80 to California State Route 89, just 55 miles from Reno Tahoe International Airport.

Primary Air Gateway: Reno-Tahoe International Airport is 58 miles northeast via all-weather Interstate 80 and State Route 89.

Secondary Air Gateway: Sacramento International Airport is 113 miles west of Homewood, CA via all-weather Interstate 80 and State Route 89.
